**Religion**- What/who do they worship? Where do they worship? What do they believe in? Priests?

**Intellectual** –Written language? Philosophy? Intellectual Achievements? Did they leave any of the following behind: art, customs, sports, dress, language, music, dance, foods, celebrations, etc.?

**Technological** - What did they invent? Were there any new developments? How have they attempted to control/regulate their environment?

**Economic** – Class structure? What jobs do they perform? How do they make money? What type of economy do they have? Do they trade with others? Do they use money?
