SPRITE CHART

Social – What were the acceptable roles for men and women? Did they have a rigid social structure (slaves, priests, kings)? Did they live in family units? Did they interact with other groups?

Political - What form of government did they have? Who was in charge? Did people vote? What was the political organization (city-states, nations, empires)?

Religion- What/who do they worship? Where do they worship? What do they believe in? Priests?

Intellectual –Written language? Philosophy? Intellectual Achievements? Did they leave any of the following behind: art, customs, sports, dress, language, music, dance, foods, celebrations, etc.?

Technological - What did they invent? Were there any new developments? How have they attempted to control/regulate their environment?

Economic – Class structure? What jobs do they perform? How do they make money? What type of economy do they have? Do they trade with others? Do they use money?
